WATER SPORTS

- Training program. T/O £3089 to date. Up take on youth courses at Killington is very low at present time. May have to cancel. Beginners courses need to engage with local parents. Needs promotion.
- Use of Sedbergh School Boats had informal arrangement to use their boats we insured them. He is now retired. School staff has changed and is risk of their boats not longer being available. IM has sent email giving dates we would like to use the boats. Not hear anything as yet. Jim and Myles do think we will get permission

Can still run courses without Sedbergh boats.

Killington have 4 Pico's, Feva, Laser, Hartley 15, ASC Wayfarer. Killington boats can only be booked out for 2 hours.

Options – Take some boats from Arnside to Killington

- Buy second hand Pico for @£500 but how to transport from point of purchase.
- Apply for grant funding to buy new boats and do it jointly with Killington so they are stored there and insured by them.
- **Killington shed.** Due to be delivered 15th May. AS to liaise with delivery company. Need shed by end of May.

Action AS to email members to help to erect the shed.

- Try out Day Saturday 25th May
 - Action JC and AN volunteered to take client's out. Make sure children put on the cruch strap.
- Killington Club Nights First one is end of 30th May. Need rota of senior members to be meet and greet and rig. Also need safety boat cover.
 - Action JC to create Google Sheet and liaise with IM re filling in Killington forms.
- Request to use Club Wanderer Road trailer to take boat to Tighnabruiach
 Action Member will pay £100 for use of. Agreed could use the trailer.
- Recommission Caravan for use as changing.

Needs clearing out as been used as storage.

Action – clear out caravan. Print signs off 'occupied' 'unoccupied'. CS to clear out. AS has spare outside storage box that could be used to store stuff from caravan?

- AS has had to reorder parts for Lasers. Sail bags have been ordered so battens
 can be left in the sails. Got 3 different bottom parts to masts and kicking straps.
 Storage mast bottoms currently kept in bottom of boats. Sail bags to be kept in
 paddle board store or could be stored in a ridge tent?
- Action AS to run training course on rigging.
- Long Term changing facilities.

Tim Chatham can do design for budget.

AS and JJ met with freeholders about the dinghy park and they were supportive.
