6. Health & Safety

Safety Boat Engine at Killington is 8 years old. It stopped when out in the Estuary so took the engine to Killington and the engine cut out during a lesson. Engine has been taken to repairer who could not identify the problem. Think fuel is separating when not used? New engine costs £2000 and guaranteed for 7yrs, less with trade in.

Safety boat at Killington stopped working. Discussed swapping engines so reliable engine Suzuki is based at Killington as have busy training schedule.

AP suggested adding additive to fuel, Coast Guards have done this.

ACTION - SWAP ENGINES, PUT ADDITIVE INTO FUEL OF TOHASHU ENGINE.

JC in contact with MA to sort out DBS checks but she's been unavailable.

7. Water Sports

• Training Programme.

• Bursary Scheme to aid low income children

Bursary – Club puts \pounds 200 aside and family applies for bursary? Proof must be provided that the family is on low income.

Put cap on number of sessions, say up to 4 free sessions for children at either Killington or Arnside and provide voucher. These are for new sessions.

If we reach limit we can say Bursary scheme has run out.

This may also allow us to apply for grants
