Implementation

- 1. Appointments to positions with the Sailing Club will be made on the basis of an individual's knowledge, skills and experience and the competences required for the role
- 2. We will set our fees at level where cost is not a barrier to taking part
- 3. We will provide a diverse range of activities and opportunities so that everybody can take part in club activity and events whatever their background, aims and interests.
- 4. Ensure that club activities are accessible as practicable, including to people with disabilities.
- 5. We will promote the club, club house and water sports as being open and welcoming to all.
- 6. We will encourage people from diverse groups to join the club, take part in club activity and in the running the club.
- 7. The effectiveness of this policy will be monitored and evaluated by the club on a regular basis.
